What does it mean to be a preceptor?

Clinical preceptors provide three hour shadowing experiences for MERIT Scholars between **June 20th – July 27th** on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. We prefer that clinicians commit to 3-5 days but are flexible and can work with your schedule. There is no additional time commitment outside of the shadowing.

MERIT works with HR to take care of all paperwork, compliance, HIPAA training, etc. Additionally, all Scholars have gone through professionalism training and a rigorous selection process. Past preceptors rated MERIT Scholars' professionalism **4.9 out of 5.**
