



## Assistant Vice Chair for LGBTQ+ Equity and Education for the Department of Medicine

- Collaborate with the Johns Hopkins Medicine Office of Diversity, Inclusion and Health Equity Program Director of LGBTQ+ Equity and Education in the planning, implementation, execution and evaluation of all LGBTQ+ related equity and education initiatives and programs;
- Establish/lead the DOM LGBTQ+ Equity and Health Education Council;
- Conduct a needs assessment to identify key gaps in LGBTQ+ support and education initiatives in the DOM;
- Develop initiatives and programming focused on LGBTQ+ equity and health education as a result of the needs assessment;
- Enhance the learning environment for DOM faculty, trainees and staff by arranging sessions in DOM to highlight key LGBTQ+ equity and health education topics
- Participate in division reviews as part of the DOM Faculty Development group to review faculty CVs;
- Be an active member of the DOM vice chair group that meets at least monthly; and
- Represent the DOM for School of Medicine, University and Health System LGBTQ+ matters.
