Details for prospective volunteer providers:

- **Bilingual or Spanish fluency preferred, not mandatory**
- **Must have a valid license to practice in Maryland**
- **Willing to be trained in epic, our electronic medical system**
- **Willing to commit at least 10 hours a month for at least 1 year**

As we are a free clinic, our medical and dental providers will be credentialed and covered for medical malpractice liability through the Federal Tort Claims Act(FTCA) before they start. We handle that process.

Our normal clinic hours are Monday to Friday from 9 to 4pm. However, we are open to other options (evenings, Saturdays) depending on the feedback from interested providers.
