



RFA for Associate Program Director of Wellbeing for the Osler Medical Residency

The Osler Medical Residency is seeking an application for an Associate Program Director (APD) for Wellbeing. This role has previously been held with great success by Dr. Heather Sateia, and we look forward to continuing to build on the work she has done over the past few years.

Candidates should have experience with program-building and an interest in exploring strategies to address wellbeing at both an individual as well as systems level. Previous experience in GME or UME is beneficial but not required.

Overarching Responsibilities of the Role Include:

- Develop and oversee wellbeing programming within the residency program that seeks to enhance professional fulfillment and reduce burnout.
- Serve as the faculty advisor for a new Osler Resident Wellbeing Committee
- Support affinity groups and committees within the residency program, such as the Women in Medicine Initiative, etc.
- Collaborate with departmental leadership on comprehensive response to wellbeing and professional fulfillment data.

The APD for Wellness will receive 10% support from the DOM and, in this role, will report to the Director of the Osler Medical Training Program in the Department of Medicine. They will also work closely with other program leaders within the Osler Medical Residency, will attend bi-monthly program leadership meetings, and participate in related program activities.
